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## CANDY GRID — HOW IT WORKS:

Every score change is worth a candy bar. **Example:** Baltimore scores first with a field goal, so the score is 3-0 Baltimore. The person who has the square representing 3 for Baltimore and 0 for San Francisco (that happens to be **Casey**) wins a candy bar. Then San Francisco scores a touchdown, making the score San Francisco: 6 Baltimore: 3. The person who has that score (**Alex Blough-Swingen**) wins. Then San Francisco kicks the extra point, so the person who has the score 7-3 for San Francisco (**Alex Spiro**) would win. Every time the score changes, someone wins, so we want a high scoring game. To make things more interesting, the person who starts the game with 0-0 wins a candy bar (**Adriana**), as does the person with the 2-2 square (**Samwise**), as it is statistically the least likely to win. Note: There will be no extra prize for end of quarter/end of game this year.

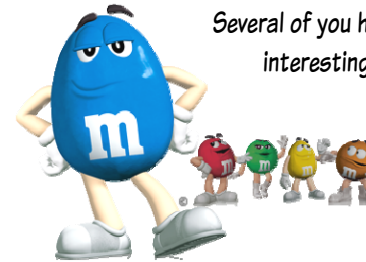
